GOI- GEF-UNDP funded IHRML Project- Dissemination Workshop & Exhibition

Nava Kerala Mission & IHRML organized a two day dissemination workshop and exhibition of GOI- GEF-UNDP India High Range Mountain Landscape (IHRML) project at Kerala Arts & Craft Village, Vellar, Kovalam, Thiruvananthapuram on June 29 & 30, 2022. Dr. T.N.Seema the Coordinator and project director detailed the special aspects of the project. A dissemination workshop was held as part of the event. MoEF & CC and the UNDP through funding from Global Environment Facility (GEF) had supported the implementation of IHRML Project which was meant for Anjunad and adjoining landscapes covering 2068.27 sq km belonging to 11 grama panchayats of Idukki, Ernakulam and Thrissur districts. KSBB had conducted two studies as part of the project and also updated the Kerala State Biodiversity Strategies and Action Plan. The dissemination workshop shared knowledge on the various activities spearheaded through the IHRML project. The officials of KSBB attended the function and participated in the exhibition where various knowledge products like awareness panels, books, booklets and brochures developed by KSBB as part of the projects were showcased. The major EKAA^{MERET} attraction of the event was the small units from different panchayaths displayed in stalls with demonstration and sale of different organic, traditional and handicraft materials.

Medicinal plant nursery techniques

As a part of the Pampa Riverine Biodiversity Rejuvenation Project of Kerala State Biodiversity Board funded by Rebuild Kerala Initiative, ten selected people from Ranni- Angadi Grama Panchayath were trained in Medicinal plant nursery techniques at the campus of ICAR-Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Thadiyoor on 27th June to 28th June 2022.

This skill enhancement training consists of detailed classes on medicinal properties of plants, propagation methods and identifying plants suitable for commercial cultivation. Besides, plant propagation techniques; stem cutting, seed germination methods, tuber cuttings, potting mixture preparation, cover filling, and planting methods were included. The sessions were handled by Dr. Rincy K Abraham, Subject Matter Specialist (Horticulture), and Ms. Gayathri S, Programme Assistant (Lab) of KVK. The participants in this training were MGNREGS workers and VSS members of Ranni-Angadi GP.

The beneficiaries of this training will work at the medicinal plant nursery which is being constructed at Valiyakavu

in Ranni Angadi Gram Panchayath as part of "Pampa Riverine Biodiversity Rejuvenation project. Ranni Angadi Gram Panchayath BMC aims to produce large scale production of medicinal plant seedlings through nursery and their marketing and manufacturing of value added products. The trainees were awarded with a Certifiacte in Medicianal plant nursery techniques issued by ICAR-KVK.



Sustainable livelihood activities -

Kuttichal Grama Panchayath

Kerala State Biodiversity Board initiated a project entitled "Implementation of stingless beekeeping practices for sustainable livelihood of selected tribal farmers at Kuttichal Grama Panchayath Thiruvananthapuram District" under the ABS scheme. The project aims at providing additional income to the tribal people through rearing stingless honeybees (meliponiculture). Twenty one tribal families of Kuttichal Gramapanchayath EKAA WE DE


benefitted from this training. The two days of training, exclusively on stingless beekeeping, dividing the colony, pure honey collection and management of the stingless bees were held. After training honeybee colonies was distributed to the trainees. Adv. G. Stephen MLA of Aruvikkara Constituency inaugurated the project on 22.06.2022 at the Interpretation Centre, Elephant Rehabilitation Centre, Kottur. Dr. C. George Thomas, Chairman, KSBB presided over the function and Member Secretary Dr. Santhoshkumar A.V. addressed the participants. President of Kutitchal Grama Panchayat, G. Manikandan, delivered the keynote address. KSBB Board members K.V. Govindan, Dr. K. Satheeshkumar and Dr. K.T Chandramohanan delivered lectures on diverse aspects of meliponiculture in connection with the workshop organized on "Sustainable Development in the Age of Climate Change". General Secretary, Federation of Indigenous Apiculture, Dr. Stephen Devanesan, delivered a lecture on meliponiculture to the participants.
